Tour the backstage and stage area until 6:45 and then meet with an orchestra musician in the musicians' lounge. Attendance at both the seminar and that evening's concert is required to receive a credit. Because the seminars overlap with pre-concert lectures, no additional credit can be earned for attending part of the pre-concert lecture which is optional. One parent per child may receive a complimentary ticket. A second parent will receive a 10% discount on their ticket. Opera Lightwalking

Lightwalkers move around each opera set, holding positions while the light crew fixes the settings. Need to be able to stand for long periods of time and walk comfortably around the set. Comfortable shoes with good tread are recommended. Should wear clothing in neutral tones (no black or white), so as not to absorb or reflect the light. Tentative dates for 2013-14 productions are: *Salome* - October 15/16; *Fatal Song* - November 12/13; *La Traviata* – January 10/11; *Turandot* – March 10; *Abduction from the Seraglio* – May 2/3.
