DM Lesson 3: Vibrations and Waves

More ideas for each portion of this lesson are on the DM website.

Hello/Welcome Song (2 minutes)

• Greet the children cheerfully and sing the DM Theme song together

Teach that Sound is Vibrations (5 mins.)

- Teach the sentence, "Sound is vibrations that travel to my ear that send a message to my brain making sounds that I can hear." (Use visual on website if desired.)
- Explain what it means.
- Have the children practice it several times.



Taste a Song/Do a Movement Activity (6 mins.)

- Remind them of the "rules" of movement:
 - 1. Stay in the little "space" around your body.
 - 2. Be careful not to bump into those around you.
 - 3. Stop moving when the music stops.
- Suggestion: Choose a song that is made from percussion instruments. Play the song while they move to it.
- Ask them questions about the song after you share it.

Vibration and Waves demos (6-10 mins.)

- Demonstrate how one thing impacting another creates vibrations that create airwaves, making sound.
- Invite the children to participate in demonstrations, either in small groups or all together

Review Song (4-6 mins.)

- Review all or part of the school song
- Remind them about **"audience manners"** and "**performance manners**:" (See Lesson 2)
- Invite some children (individually or as a group) come up to perform parts or all of the song for the group. Have them bow and the class clap.

"Adios, Amigos" (1 min.)

• Sing it together to close your lesson
